STARRING...

CHATEAU DE LA ROULERIE – PHILIPPE GERMAIN



Château de la Roulerie is co-owned by Chateau de Fesles in the Anjou region, very close to the village of Bonnezeaux. The origins of the chateau can be traced back as far as 1070, when the original buildings were constructed. Although the chateau has been remodelled by its various owners over the centuries. The most recent owner up until 1991 was Gaston Lenôtre, a celebrated pastry chef.

The new owners have taken this stumbling estate and turned it around. The son of the owner since 1991 Philippe Germain controls Château de la Roulerie. Although Philippe has been living at La Roulerie since 2001 and since 2004 has been making the wine with his older brother, Thierry (Domaine des Roches Neuves), 2004, was the first year they had made wine at La Roulerie. Previously the wine had made at Château de Fesles in Bonnezeaux. Apparently wine had not been made at Roulerie for nearly 20 years since Dominique Jadeau sold the property to Gaston Lenôtre.
